Job Description and Responsibilities:

- Lead daily prayers and deliver the Friday and Eid Khutbahs
- Work with IAGD Management and be a Leader of all religious activities in the masjid.
- Inspire the spiritual growth of all segments of the IAGD community through classes, seminars, workshops, adult programs and regular Friday evening lectures.
- Work with IAGD Management and its Youth Committee & Youth Director(s) to develop youth programs to cater to the religious, social and developmental needs of the IAGD Community youth.
- Teach at least one class on religious matters in the IAGD Weekend School.
- Be committed to working with people from a range of diverse backgrounds, cultures, identities and life experiences
- Foster unity and inclusion within Islamic guidelines among all members of the Southeast Michigan Muslim community
- Engage in interfaith activities to foster strong relationships with various faith communities in the area and be a champion for Islam and Muslims
- Provide consultation to IAGD Management and its committees on religious matters.
- Maintain regular office hours for the community to provide advice on religious and personal issues
- Provide funeral services and guidance
- Provide religious matrimonial services and guidance / counseling
- Coordinate with masjid management and actively support IAGD fundraising events & Ramadan and other special programs.

- Connect with the community on regular basis by all possible communication channels including phone, email and/or social media.

Qualification / Requirements: Applicant must have excellent command of the English and Arabic languages and be skilled in written and verbal communications. Applicant must have degrees from a recognized Islamic University and attained the level of “Mufti” or “Alim.” Applicants must have a minimum of 5 years work experience in the U.S. Applicants must have excellent communication skills to deal with a diverse community, the media, and interfaith groups. It is preferred that the candidate be a Hafiz and having excellent Quranic recitation/Qiraat. It is also preferred that applicants already be a citizen or legal resident of the U.S.
